

Kindergarten Supply List 2010-2011

The following supplies should be purchased, labeled and brought to school the day of Kindergarten Orientation: **Friday, August 6, 2010.**

1 Kinder-Mat (5/8" x 19" x 45" opened and folds 4 times) **Note: All oversized mats will be returned. No built in pillows, blankets, etc. Space is limited.**

1 King size pillowcase (to fit over mat)

1 box of tissue

1 roll of paper towels

1 book bag, large enough to hold a legal size folder

1 box of eight classic crayons (**No large, jumbo, glitter or scented crayons**)

1 8oz. Purel hand sanitizer

1 large Elmers glue stick (.77 oz.)

The teacher will purchase the remainder of supplies used throughout the year. **A supply fee of \$48.00 is due by August 6, 2010.** Checks should be made payable to St. Jude School and mailed to

Examples of items to be purchased with the \$48.00 supply fee include:

pencils	pocket folders
erasers	brown envelopes
scissors	games for learning centers
glue	art and craft supplies
colors (to be given mid year)	science experiment supplies
markers	ingredients for cooking activities
St. Jude bank bag	construction paper

We also ask that each child have a change of clothes in case of an accident. **This should be kept in a Ziploc bag in their book bag at all times.** Boys should have pants/shorts, underwear and socks. Girls should have shorts, underwear and socks. You do not have to provide a complete uniform. A pair of navy gym shorts with the other required items is fine. In the event of an accident, we do not want to draw any unnecessary attention to the child. Please bear this in mind as you prepare this change of clothes for your child.

PLEASE label all sweatshirts, jackets, and any other clothing for easy identification.

The children will receive a snack each day after naptime. More information about this will be sent to you at a later date.

Please note the following:

1. No rolling book sacks are allowed in grades Pre K – 4th
2. Tennis shoes should be predominately white, gray, or navy.
