

Welcome to the St. Jude Computer Lab!!



During the 2011-2012 school year grades 5-8 will visit the Middle School Computer Lab. Emphasis will be placed on keyboarding, computer applications using Office 2003, and accessing the Internet. Seventh and eighth graders will also be introduced to video, digital photography and photo/audio editing using Open Source software.

Equipment - The lab consists of 30 PCs with color monitors and internet access, 2 black/white laser network printers, 1 color laser network printer, a scanner, 9 digital cameras, a Flip video camera, an LCD projector and 1 interactive Smart Board. We also have access to a wireless writing tablet, Qwizdom Interactive Response System, Webcams, and GPS handheld devices.

Format of Class - Daily class will consist of the following:

- Prayer
- Keyboarding
- Explanation/Demonstration of activity
- Individual or group computer work
- Closing/wrap-up/clean-up

Grading - A computer grade will be given each enrichment rotation. The St. Jude grading scale will be used. Every student starts with 100 points. Points will be deducted for incomplete or missing work, and incorrect assignments. Cooperation, listening, and following directions are very important! Conduct cards will be signed for any misbehavior.

Computer Lab Usage - The lab is open to all students every day from 8:00AM until school starts. It is also available at certain free periods during the day. Students must make an appointment to use the computers outside of class time. No student is allowed in the computer lab unless a teacher is present.
